A Special Election will be conducted in Mason County on April 26, 2011. The following districts are eligible to vote in the special election: Fire Protection District No. 1 and Pioneer School District No. 402. The following measures will appear on the April 26, 2011 Special Election ballot.

Mason County Fire Protection District No. 1
Emergency Medical Services Regular Property Levy

The Board of Commissioners for Mason County Fire Protection District No. 1 adopted Resolution No. 2011-1, concerning a proposition to finance maintenance and operations expenses. This proposition would authorize the District to levy taxes for the provision of emergency medical services pursuant to RCW 84.52.069 in the amount of \$0.25 per \$1000.00 of assessed valuation for each of six consecutive years beginning with levy year 2011 for collection in 2012.

Pioneer School District No. 402
General Obligation Bonds--\$24,500,000
Proposition No. 1

The Board of Directors of Pioneer School District No. 402 adopted Resolution No. 2-2011, concerning a proposition to finance expansion, renovation and construction of schools. This proposition would authorize the District to expand and renovate Pioneer Primary School to accommodate Grades K-5, and construct and equip a new middle school (Grades 6-8) to replace Pioneer Intermediate/Middle School; to issue no more than \$24,500,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within a maximum term of twenty (20) years; and levy excess property taxes annually to repay the bonds, all as provided in Resolution No. 2-2011.
