Notice of Logic and Accuracy Test

In accordance with RCW 29A.12.130, the Mason County Auditor's Office will conduct an official Logic and Accuracy Test on Thursday, August 5, 2010 at 8:30 a.m. for the August 17 Primary Election. The test will take place at the Mason County Auditor's Office, 411 N. 5th Street, Shelton. The purpose of the test is to verify the system will correctly count the votes cast for all candidates and measures appearing on the ballot. Observers are welcome.

Dates Ballots will be Mailed

Ballots for the August 17, 2010 Primary Election will be mailed to voters on July 30, 2010. Ballots to military and overseas voters were mailed on July 1-2, 2010. Because Mason County votes entirely by mail, a ballot will automatically be sent to eligible voters eighteen days prior to each election.

Notice of Accessibility

Accessible voting equipment is available at the Auditor's Office during business hours beginning July 28, 2010 until 8:00 p.m. election night, August 17, 2010. The voting equipment is available to any voter wishing to use it, but the equipment has special features to allow voters with disabilities to vote independently.
