
**How to vote**

Proposition for Property Tax Levy Lid Lift

The Board of Central Mason Fire and EMS adopted Resolution No. 344, concerning a proposition to finance current operation and maintenance expenses. This proposition would increase the District's regular tax levy to \$1.48 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation beginning in 2013 for collection in 2014. The dollar amount of the 2013 levy shall serve as the base for computing the limitations for subsequent levies as provided by RCW 84.55.

**Fire Protection District No. 11  
Proposition for Property Tax Levy Lid Lift**

The Board of Commissioners for Mason County Fire Protection District No. 11 adopted Resolution No. 13-02, concerning a proposition to finance maintenance and operations expenses. This proposition would authorize the acquisition of equipment and supplies, personnel costs, and training expenses. This proposition would increase the District's regular tax levy to an amount not to exceed \$1.50 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation beginning in 2013 for collection in 2014. The dollar amount of the 2013 levy shall serve as the base for computing the limitations for subsequent levies as provided by RCW 84.55.
