Voter Registration Information & Deadlines

All voter registration applications, transfers from another county, changes of address within Mason County and other registration updates, submitted by mail or online, must be postmarked by Monday, January 13, 2014 or may be delivered to the Mason County Auditor's Office no later than 4:30 p.m., Monday, January 13, 2014 to be eligible for the February 11, 2014 Special Election.

Persons not already registered in Washington State may register in-person no later than Monday, February 3, 2014 at the Mason County Auditor's Office, Monday thru Friday, 8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. The Auditor's Office is closed from 12:30 p.m. – 1:30 p.m. daily.

Notice of Drop Box Locations

Mason County votes entirely by mail and regular polling places will not be open. Return postage is required to return a voted ballot and must be postmarked by the day of the election. However, no postage is required if you deposit your ballot in an open ballot drop box before 8:00 p.m. on Election Night. A list of all ballot drop boxes will be included with your ballot material.

Accessible voting equipment is available at the Mason County Auditor's Office, January 23 – February 11, 2014, during regular business hours. On Election Day, it is available 8:30 a.m. – 8:00 p.m. The voting equipment is available to any voter who wishes to use it, but the equipment has special features to allow voters with disabilities to vote independently.
