

City of Shelton
Emergency Medical Services Levy

The Shelton City Commission passed Resolution No. 1089-0416, to allow voters to decide whether to renew a regular property tax levy in the amount of 50 cents or less per thousand dollars of assessed valuation for each of six consecutive years, for the purpose of providing emergency medical services and acquiring equipment in order to provide emergency medical services.

Shall the City of Shelton be authorized to impose a regular property tax levy of 50 cents or less per thousand dollars of assessed valuation for each of six consecutive years?

Fire Protection District No. 11
Emergency Medical Services Regular Property Levy

The Board of Fire Commissioners of Mason County Fire Protection District No. 11 adopted Resolution No. 16-04, which includes a proposition to replace its expiring emergency medical services property tax levy. This proposition would authorize the board of commissioners to continue to fund emergency medical services for its citizens by imposing a regular property tax levy pursuant to RCW 84.52.069 of \$.50 per \$1,000.00 of assessed valuation for a period of six (6) consecutive years beginning with levy year 2016 for collection in 2017.

Emergency Medical Services Regular Property Levy

The Board of Commissioners for Mason County Fire Protection District No. 17 adopted Resolution No. 137, which includes a proposition to authorize a regular property tax levy, to replace an expiring levy, for the provisions of emergency medical services pursuant to RCW 84.52.069 in the amount of \$0.25 per \$1,000.00 of assessed valuation for each six (6) consecutive years beginning with the levy year 2016 for collection in 2017.
