
How to vote

Special Election - Proposition 1
Bonds To Renovate Mid-Valley Hospital

The Commission of Public Hospital District No. 3, Okanogan County, Washington adopted Resolution No. 537, concerning a proposition to finance hospital renovation. This proposition would authorize the District to renovate Mid-Valley Hospital (including upgrading and improving heating, ventilation, air conditioning and plumbing systems; acquiring and installing a new electronic medical records technology system; and renovating and repairing support service areas); issue no more than \$3,800,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within 15 years; and levy annual excess property taxes to repay the bonds, all as provided in Resolution No. 537.
