

Precinct **SAMPLE BALLOT**


Instruction Text:

Every registered voter in Fire protection No. 5 and Raymond School District, Pacific County will receive his or her ballot by mail for the August 18, 2009 Special/Primary Election. The ballots will be mailed out on July 29, 2009. Registered voters may mail or deposit their ballot at the following locations: Auditor's office (South Bend) up to and including the day of the Election. Also we have a drive up deposit box for your convenience. The Auditor's offices will be open on August 18, 2009 from 7:00 AM to 8:00 PM to receive voted ballots. Election Day only, ballots may also be deposited at the Raymond High School, 1016 Commercial St., Raymond. You may obtain a replacement ballot if the original ballot is destroyed, spoiled or lost; call (360) 875-9317. Replacement ballots may be requested in person at the Auditor's offices. Any ballots postmarked after the election will not be counted. The County Auditor's offices are ADA compliant and registration and voting aids are available upon request.
