




Instruction Text:

You may return your ballot to the Pacific County Auditor's office in South Bend, 300 Memorial Dr., or Long Beach, 318 N 2<sup>nd</sup> St. Both these location have a drive up drop box also. On Election Day only the Auditor's office will be open from 7:00 AM to 8:00 PM. Election Day only there will be two other drop sites besides the Auditor's offices; Raymond High School, 1016 Commercial St., Raymond and Ocean Park Library, 1308 256<sup>th</sup>, Ocean Park. The Auditor's offices are ADA compliant, voting aids are available upon request.

Ballots may be returned by mail, place a 42 cent stamp on the ballot return envelope. **YOU BALLOT MUST BE POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN THE DAY OF THE ELECTION.**
