 City of Raymond Proposition No.1 Capital Repair and Improvement Levy
 The City Council of the City of Raymond adopted Ordinance No. 1852 concerning a levy for capital purposes. This levy funds major maintenance and capital repairs to City facilities, including the fire hall/police station, Tourist Center, public works heating system, Raymond Theatre and City Hall, and authorizes the following excess levy on all taxable property within the City:
