RESOLUTION 2016-23**

**IN THE MATTER OF}
DESIGNATING SKAMANIA COUNTY PARKS}
AND RECREATION DISTRICT NO. 1 TO BE LOCATED}
IN AN AREA OF UNDERWOOD, WA AND SETTING BOUNDARIES}**

WHEREAS, on the 2ND day of May, 2016, there was filed with the Auditor of Skamania County, a petition for the purpose of forming a Parks and Recreation District under the provisions of RCW 36.69.010 et seq., accompanied by an obligation signed by two of the petitioners agreeing to pay the cost of publication of the notice provided for in RCW 36.69.040, and said Auditor having found and determined that said petition contains a sufficient number of signatures of qualified persons, and having attached thereto the certificate of sufficiency, and on May 3, 2016 transmitted the same to the Board of County Commissioners, and said Board, by Resolution 2016-17 entered upon their minutes, fixed Tuesday, June 21, 2016 at the hour of 5:30 p.m. of said day, at the Commissioners' Meeting Room, in the Skamania County Courthouse, Stevenson, Washington as the time and place for the hearing of said petition; and,

WHEREAS, at said time and place said petition came on for hearing, proof having been made to the satisfaction of this Board that Notice hereof had been given for the time and in the manner provided by law, and no objection having been made or filed, the Board proceeded to hear the petition and upon conclusion made the following findings:

- I. That the object of the district is to operate and maintain all land and buildings included in tax lots 01302200040000 and 013022000501000, at 951 Schoolhouse Road, Underwood, WA, and establish authority to provide leisure time activities and maintain facilities in a nonprofit nature as a public service to the residents of the area.
- II. The name and number of the district shall be Skamania County Parks and Recreation District No. 1, and the boundaries thereof shall be and are determined as in that portion of Underwood, WA hereby described in Exhibit A.
- III. The proposition for the formation of the proposed park and recreation district shall be submitted to the voters of the two Underwood voting districts, Underwood North 310 and Underwood South 311 for their approval or rejection at the next general election to be held on November 8, 2016. The election shall be conducted in accordance with the provisions of RCW 29A.04.321 for district elections. Notices of the election for the formation of the park and recreation district shall be generally and briefly the purpose thereof and shall give boundaries of the proposed district and name the day of the election and the hours during which the polls will be open.
- IV. The proposition to be submitted to the voters shall be stated in such manner that the voters may indicate yes or no upon the proposition of forming the proposed park and recreation district.
- V. The initial park and recreation commissioners shall be elected at the same election, but his election shall be null and void if the district is not authorized to be formed. No primary shall be held to nominate candidates for the initial commissioner positions. Candidates shall run for specific commission positions. The person who receives the greatest number of votes for each commission position shall be elected to that


position. The three persons who are elected receiving the greatest number of votes shall be elected to four-year terms of office if the election is held in an odd-numbered year of three-year terms of office if the election is held in an even-numbered year. The other two persons who are elected shall be elected to two-year terms of office if the election is held in an odd-numbered year or one-year terms of office if the election is held in an even-numbered year. The initial commissioners shall take office immediately upon being elected and qualified, but the length of such terms shall be computed from the first day of January in the year following this election.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of Skamania County hereby set the name and boundary of the Skamania County Parks and Recreation District No. 1.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the petition proposes to impose a levy of \$.20 per thousand dollars of assessed value on property located within the two Underwood voting districts, Underwood North 310 and Underwood South 311. These funds would be used to operate and maintain the buildings and property as defined in Exhibit A.

The name and number of the district shall be Skamania County Parks and Recreation District No. 1, and the boundaries thereof shall be and are determined as voter precincts Underwood South 311 and a portion of Underwood North 310 which are more particularly described as follows:

Underwood South 311

Commencing at the intersection of the north shore of the Columbia River and the north-south centerline of Section 25, Township 3 North, Range 9 East, W.M.; thence north along the north-south centerlines of Sections 25 and 24, same Township and Range to the intersection with the centerline of a County road known as Cook-Underwood Road; thence easterly and southerly along said centerline of said Cook-Underwood Road to the intersection with the centerline of State Highway 14 in the southwest corner of Section 23, Township 3 North, Range 10 East, W.M.; thence south to the State Boundary; thence west along the State Boundary to a point south of the point of beginning; thence north to the point of beginning.





I HEREBY CERTIFY that this office has checked the attached Petition for the Proposed Underwood Park & Recreation District.



PETITION AUTHORIZING CREATION OF A PARKS AND RECREATION DISTRICT IN UNDERWOOD, WA

The Underwood Community Council adopted a resolution on March 3, 2016 concerning a proposition to form the Underwood Parks and Recreation District, under RCW 36.69, to operate and maintain all land and buildings included in tax lots 01302200040000 and 01302200050100, at 951 Schoolhouse Rd., Underwood, WA. These two lots, known as Underwood Park, include the Underwood Community Center Building, the adjacent fields, parking areas, horse arena, community garden, the Underwood Post Office (981 Schoolhouse Rd.) and the adjacent residence (991 Schoolhouse Rd.)

If approved by a majority of those voting in the two Underwood voting districts, Underwood North 310 (commencing at the centerline intersections of State Road 14 and Cook-Underwood Road in the southeast corner of Section 23, Township 3 North, Range 10 East, W.M.; 1 thence northerly and westerly along said centerline of said Cook-Underwood Road to its intersection with the north-south centerline of Section 24, Township 3 North, Range 9 East, W.M.; 2 thence north along said north-south centerline of said Section 24 to the north line of said Section 24; 3 thence east along north line of Section 24 to the northeast corner thereof; 4 thence north along the west lines of Sections 18, 7 and 6, Township 3 North, Range 10 East, W.M., to the County Line at northwest corner of Section 6, same Township and Range; 5 thence east along the County Line and the north lines of Sections 6, 5, 4, 3 and 2, to the intersection with the White Salmon River, said intersection point being the east line of Skamania County; 6 thence south along the east County Line and the thread of the White Salmon River to the intersection with the Columbia River; 7 thence south along the County Line to the State Line in the Channel of the Columbia River; 8 thence west along the State Line in the channel of the Columbia River to a point directly south of the point of beginning; 9 thence north to the point of beginning, excluding Sections 2 and 3, Township 3 North, Range 10 East of the Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, State Of Washington) and Underwood South 311 (commencing at the intersection of the north shore of the Columbia River and the north-south centerline of Section 25, Township 3 North, Range 9 East, W.M.; 1 thence north along the north-south centerlines of Sections 25 and 24, same Township and Range to the intersection with the centerline of a County road known as Cook-Underwood Road; 2 thence easterly and southerly along said centerline of said Cook-Underwood Road to the intersection with the centerline of State Highway 14 in the southwest corner of Section 23, Township 3 North, Range 10 East, W.M.; 3 thence south to the State Boundary; 4 thence west along the State Boundary to a point south of the point of beginning; 5 thence north to the point of beginning), the measure will establish a Parks and Recreation District with authority to provide leisure time activities and maintain facilities in a nonprofit nature as a public service to the residents of the area.

The Park and Recreation District will be governed by five elected Parks and Recreation Commissioners.

There will be an additional proposition to provide a method to fund the District. That proposition provides for a levy of \$0.20 per thousand dollars of assessed value on property located within the two Underwood voting districts. These funds would be used to operate and maintain the buildings and property as defined above.
