To vote in favor of a measure completely fill in the box provided to the left of the words "YES" or "APPROVED", to vote against a measure, completely fill in the box provided to the left of the words "NO" or "REJECTED". To correct a vote, do not erase, draw a line through the incorrect text of the candidate's name or ballot measure response and vote the correct box provided. Unless specifically allowed by law, more than one vote for an office or ballot measure will be an over-vote and no votes for that office or ballot measure will be counted. If needed request a replacement ballot. **AFTER VOTING - refold your ballot the same way you received it.**
