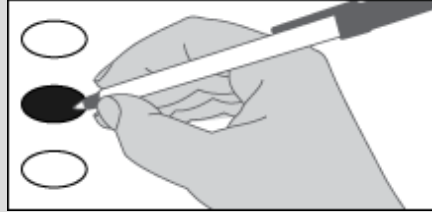

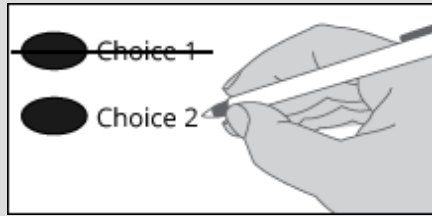
How to vote

Vote for one in each race. If you vote for more than one, no votes will be counted for that race.

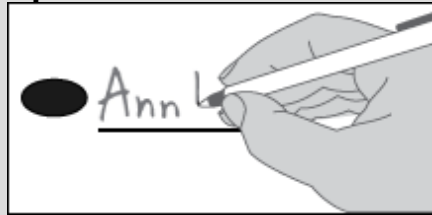
How to correct a mistake

Maintenance and Operations Levy

The Board of Directors of Mount Pleasant School District No. 29-93 approved a proposition for educational levies. This proposition provides for the support of educational programs, facilities, maintenance and operations by authorizing the levy of the following excess taxes on all taxable property within the District, as specified in District Resolution No. 2018-2019-3

Proposition No. 1

Bonds to Expand Capacity and Improve Safety and Infrastructure

The Board of Directors of White Salmon Valley School District No. 405-17 adopted Resolution No. 18/19-06, concerning a proposition to expand capacity and improve safety and infrastructure. This proposition would authorize the District to: acquire modular classrooms (including one for the Health & Wellness Center); make parking lot safety improvements; construct a multipurpose facility for school and community use; construct outdoor elementary school covered play structures; make District-wide interior system improvements; reconfigure Park Center Building; issue no more than \$7,000,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within 21 years; and levy annual excess property taxes to repay the bonds, all as provided in Resolution No. 18/19-06.
