Replacement ballots may be obtained by contacting the Spokane County Elections Office at 509-477-2320 or in person from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday thru Friday at 1033 W Gardner Ave Spokane WA 99260. Voter Service Centers will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Election Day. Registration Deadlines: The last day for mail in and online voter registrations and transfers for the August 6, 2013 Primary Election is Monday July 8, 2013. The last day of in-person registration for voters not currently registered in Washington State for the August 6, 2013 Primary Election is Monday July 29, 2013. In-person registration will occur only at the Spokane County Elections Office in the Gardner Center Building, 1033 W Gardner Ave, Spokane WA 99260.

Canvassing Board Meetings: The Spokane County Canvassing Board will hold public meetings for the August 6, 2013 Primary Election on Friday August 16, 2013 at 1:00 p.m. and on Tuesday August 20, 2013 at 1:00 pm. These meetings will take place at the Spokane County Elections Office at 1033 W Gardner Ave, Spokane WA 99260.
