Replacement ballots may be obtained by contacting the Spokane County Elections Office at 509-477-2320 or in person from 8:30 am to 4:00 pm Monday thru Friday at 1033 W Gardner Ave Spokane WA 99260. Voter Service Centers will be open from 7:00 am to 8:00 pm on Election Day. Registration Deadlines: The last day for mail in and online voter registrations and transfers for the November 5, 2013 General Election is Monday October 7, 2013. (Please note that the last day to have mail postmarked will be Saturday October 5, 2013) The last day of in-person registration for voters not currently registered in Washington State for the November 5, 2013 General Election is Monday October 28, 2013. In-person registration will occur only at the Spokane County Elections Office in the Gardner Center Building, 1033 W Gardner Ave, Spokane WA 99260.

Canvassing Board Meetings: The Spokane County Canvassing Board will hold public meetings for the November 5, 2013 General Election on Friday November 15, 2013 at 1:00 p.m.; Friday November 22, 2013 at 1:00 pm; and on Tuesday November 26, 2013 at 1:00 pm.
