- May 9, 2016 Begin canvassing of ballots (Starting time 8:00 a.m.)

- **May 16, 2016 Last Day for In Person Registration for voters who are not registered in the State of Washington for the May 24, 2016 Presidential Primary Election**
- May 23, 2016 Final Processing of Ballots (counting) 10:00 a.m.
- **May 24, 2016 Election Day – Voter Service Centers open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.; ballot counting at 11:00 a.m.; Ballot Drop Boxes will be locked at 8:00 p.m.; Election Results will be released at approximately 8:20 p.m.**
- May 25, 2016 Continue ballot counting 2:00 p.m.: Results updated by 5:00 p.m.
- June 2, 2016 Canvassing Board Meeting 11:00 a.m. (Ballot/Signature Issues)
- June 6, 2016 Continue ballot counting 3:30 p.m.: Results updated by 4:15 p.m.
- June 7, 2016 Canvassing Board Meeting 11:30 a.m. (Certification of Election)
