The polls of said Special Election will be and remain open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. of said day (unless at the hour of closing there are any electors in any polling place desiring to vote, and who are qualified to participate therein, and who have not been able to do so since appearing at the polling place, in which event said polls shall be kept open reasonably long enough after the hour of closing to allow those present at this hour to vote).

**PROPOSITION 1
DEER PARK SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 414-200-61
HIGH SCHOOL MODERNIZATION AND EXPANSION BONDS - \$7,700,000**

The Board of Directors of Deer Park School District No. 414-200-61 adopted Resolution No. 8-2002-2003, concerning a proposition to finance high school modernization and expansion. This proposition would authorize the District to modernize and expand Deer Park High School, issue no more than \$7,700,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within 20 years, and levy annual excess property taxes to repay the bonds, all as provided in Resolution No. 8-2002-2003. **PROPOSITION 1
LIBERTY SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 362
SCHOOL AND ATHLETIC FACILITIES BONDS - \$4,990,000**

The Board of Directors of Liberty School District No. 362 adopted Resolution No. 02-03/05, concerning a proposition to finance and construct school and athletic facilities. This proposition would authorize the District to construct and equip a new gymnasium and commons/community center at Liberty High School and a new football/track field near S. North Pine Creek Road, make related safety, playground and parking improvements, issue no more than \$4,990,000 of general obligation bonds, maturing within 20 years, and levy annual excess property taxes to repay such bonds, all as provided in Resolution No. 02-03/05. **PROPOSITION NO. 1
REARDAN-EDWALL SCHOOL FACILITY IMPROVEMENT
GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS - \$5,575,000**

The Board of Directors of Reardan-Edwall School District No. 9 passed Resolution No. 4-02/03 concerning this proposition to issue school bonds. This proposition will authorize the District to construct improvements to the educational facilities of the District, issue \$5,575,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within a maximum term of fifteen (15) years, and levy property taxes annually, in addition to regular tax levies to repay such bonds, all as more fully described in Resolution No. 4-02/03.
