FOR A SPECIAL PROPOSITION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Special Election in Deer Park School District No. 414-200-61, Great Northern School District No. 312, Nine Mile Falls School District No. 325-179 and Riverside School District No. 416-62, Spokane County, State of Washington, to submit to the qualified electors thereof, for their approval and adoption or rejection, special propositions, will be held March 9, 2004. At which Special Election the polls will be and remain open from 7 o'clock in the morning until 8 o'clock in the evening of said day (unless at the hour of closing there are any electors in any polling place desiring to vote, and who are qualified to participate therein, and who have not been able to do so since appearing at the polling place, in which event said polls shall be kept open reasonably long enough after the hour of closing to allow those present at this hour to vote). Said Special Election shall be held at the polling places listed at the end of this notice for each precinct in the County holding a Special Election.

This proposition authorizes the District to update and make safety improvements to Nine Mile Falls Elementary School, update, expand and make safety improvements to Lake Spokane Elementary School, update and expand science classrooms at Lakeside High School, issue \$7,990,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within a maximum term of 20 years, and levy property taxes annually, in addition to regular tax levies, to repay such bonds, all as provided in Resolution #2-04.
