NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Special Election in Newport School District No. 56-415, Spokane County, State of Washington, to submit to the qualified electors thereof, for their approval and adoption or rejection, a special proposition, will be held April 27, 2004. At which Special Election the polls will be and remain open from 7 o'clock in the morning until 8 o'clock in the evening of said day (unless at the hour of closing there are any electors in any polling place desiring to vote, and who are qualified to participate therein, and who have not been able to do so since appearing at the polling place, in which event said polls shall be kept open reasonably long enough after the hour of closing to allow those present at this hour to vote). Said Special Election shall be held at the polling places listed at the end of this notice for each precinct in the County holding a Special Election.

NEWPORT CONSOLIDATED JOINT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 56-415
SCHOOL MODERNIZATION AND EXPANSION BONDS - \$6,640,000**

The Board of Directors of Newport Consolidated Joint School District No. 56-415 adopted Resolution No. 7-2003-2004, concerning a proposition to finance school modernization and expansion. This proposition would authorize the District to modernize and expand Sadie Halstead Middle School and modernize Newport High School; issue no more than \$6,640,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within 20 years; and levy annual excess property taxes to pay and retire the bonds, all as provided in Resolution No. 7-2003-2004.
