NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Special Election in Reardan-Edwall School District No.9 and Rosalia School District No. 320, Spokane County, State of Washington, to submit to the qualified electors thereof, for their approval and adoption or rejection, special propositions, will be on Tuesday February 7, 2006. This Special Election shall be conducted by mail. Ballots for this Special Election must be postmarked no later than Election Day, Tuesday, February 7, 2006 and be delivered to the Spokane County Elections Office no later than Thursday, February 6, 2006. Ballots may also be delivered to the Spokane County Auditor's Office in the County Courthouse during normal business hours, 8:30 am to 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday through Election Day or the Spokane County Elections Office at 1033 W. Gardner Ave. in Spokane during normal business hours through Election Day, except that the Elections Office only, shall be open for ballot collection from 7:00 am until 8:00 pm on Election Day, February 7, 2006.

To indicate your vote, you must completely blacken the Oval to the left of the issue's response.
