Unless specifically allowed by law, more than one vote for an office or ballot measure will be an overvote and no votes for that office or ballot measure will be counted.

If you sign or otherwise identify yourself on a ballot, the ballot will not be counted.

REFERENDUM MEASURE 67

The legislature passed Engrossed Substitute Senate Bill 5726 (ESSB 5726) concerning insurance fair conduct related to claims for coverage or benefits and voters have filed a sufficient referendum petition on this bill.

This bill would make it unlawful for insurers to unreasonably deny certain coverage claims, and permit treble damages plus attorney fees for that and other violations. Some health insurance carries would be exempt.

SPOKANE COUNTY
ADVISORY BALLOT PROPOSITION ON EXTENDING
CONSERVATION FUTURES TAX**

In 1997 and 2002 the Board of County Commissioners, after positive advisory ballot propositions, levied for five year time frames an amount of six cents per thousand dollars of assessed value against all taxable property within Spokane County the proceeds used solely for the acquisition of conservation futures land, open space land, forest land, protecting streams or water supply and conserving wildlife habitat. 4,296 acres were purchased. The present levy expires 2007.

This proposition would authorize the City to pay the costs of a new city hall building, renovate the existing city hall and fire station for fire protection services, renovate the city's park storage building for police services, and other capital improvements; issue \$3,700,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within a maximum term of 30 years to pay for such municipal facilities and improvements; and levy annual excess property tax levies to pay and retire such bonds, as provided in Ordinance No. C-657.
