**VOTE FOR ONLY ONE CANDIDATE IN EACH RACE**

**FILL IN THE OVAL** like this:

To vote for a candidate whose name is not printed on the ballot, write the candidate's name on the line provided and fill in the oval next to the line.

**IF YOU MAKE A MISTAKE** Draw a line through the candidate's entire name  ~~George Washington~~ You then have the option of making another choice if you wish. The instructions on the security envelope may also be used to change your vote to another choice.

Unless specifically allowed by law, more than one vote for an office or ballot measure will be an overvote and no votes for that office or ballot measure will be counted. In order for your ballot to be counted, it must be either postmarked or deposited at a designated deposit site no later than 8:00 P.M. on election day.

**READ: Each candidate for partisan office may state a political party that he or she prefers. A candidate's preference does not imply that the candidate is nominated or endorsed by the party, or that the party approves of or associates with that candidate.**
