This measure would restore the 2009 property tax levy to \$1.50 per \$1,000.00 of assessed valuation for collection in 2010 and authorize a limit factor of 104% for each of the five succeeding years. The maximum allowable levy in 2014 shall be used to determine future increases as allowed by Chapter 84.55 RCW.
