The City of Spokane approved Resolution No. 2010-0008, authorizing a ballot proposition imposing additional regular property tax levies to be used exclusively for EMS - Emergency Medical Services for the years 2011 through 2016 in the sum of 50¢ per \$1,000 of 2010 assessed value as set forth in Ordinance No. C-34568.

The Board of Fire Commissioners of Spokane County Fire Protection District No. 10 adopted Resolution 10-03 concerning a proposition to reauthorize an emergency medical services property tax levy.
