### Instructions to Voters in the 2004 Primary

The blanket primary used in Washington State since the 1930's has been successfully challenged in the State courts by the major political parties. The result is that for this primary only, the voter will first have to make a choice about what type of ballot they wish to vote. The choices are for one of the three major political parties or for non-partisan races and issues only.

Non-Partisan Ballot: means, judicial offices, ballot issues and other offices without a party label.

If you choose not to vote a party ballot, you may only vote on non-partisan races and issues using the non-partisan ballot.

Separate ballots have been provided for each major political party. These ballots include non-partisan races and issues; red-stripe for Democratic, green-stripe for Republican and blue-stripe for Libertarian. The white non-partisan ballot is for those voters that only want to vote the non-partisan races and issues. **YOU MUST CHOOSE ONLY ONE BALLOT TO VOTE.** Though party affiliation is inferred by choosing a political party ballot, no record will be made of the ballot you choose. Only return **ONE** voted ballot and discard the remaining three ballots. If you vote more than one political party ballot, none of your votes for political party candidates will count. You may vote a non-partisan ballot, regardless of any party affiliation.
