



This proposition would authorize the District to: upgrade or modernize the junior/senior high and elementary schools, build a high school gymnasium/auditorium and classrooms, make District-wide safety and security improvements, expand student access to classroom technology, enhance learning environments, and update plumbing, electrical and heating systems; issue no more than \$10,520,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within 20 years; and levy annual excess property taxes to repay the bonds, all as provided in Resolution No. 2014-2015-01.
