



Proposition 1

The Board of Directors of Chewelah School District No. 36 adopted Resolution No. 2012-2013-2 concerning a proposition to finance renovation and improvement of schools. This proposition would authorize the District to renovate Jenkins High School to accommodate Grades 7-12 (including upgrading safety, HVAC, mechanical, electrical and technology systems; renovating existing classrooms and gymnasium; constructing additional classrooms, all-weather track and new multipurpose space for performing arts/gymnasium) and improve portions of Gess Elementary; issue no more than \$9,990,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within 20 years; and levy annual excess property taxes to repay the bonds, as provided in Resolution No. 2012-2013-2.
