



The Stevens County Board of Commissioners has adopted resolution 36-2015 regarding the formation of the Upper Columbia Pool District pursuant to chapter 36.69 RCW. The District, if approved, would encompass land lying within the boundaries of the City of Kettle Falls, Stevens County. The resolution proposes a property tax levy of \$17,491.34 at an estimated \$0.215 per one thousand dollars assessed valuation in 2015 for the District maintenance and operation in year 2016.

The Board of Fire Commissioners of Stevens County Fire Protection District No. 1 adopted Resolution No. 2015-03 concerning a proposition to acquire, construct and equip new fire stations. This proposition would authorize the District to acquire, construct and equip new fire stations in Suncrest and Loon Lake and purchase firefighting and lifesaving equipment; issue no more than \$6,500,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within 20 years; and levy annual excess property taxes to repay the bonds, all as provided in Resolution No. 2015-03.

Levy Lift For Fire Protection/Emergency Medical Services Staffing and Operational Expenses
The Board of Fire Commissioners of Stevens County Fire Protection District No. 1, adopted Resolution No. 2015-04, concerning a proposition to fund for protection/emergency medical staffing and operational expenses. This proposition would authorize a 2016 regular property tax rate of \$1.40/\$1,000 assessed value. In 2016-2021, the limit factor will be 100% plus the percentage change in the CPI as described in the Resolution. The 2021 levy amount will be used to calculate subsequent levy limits and any increase thereafter will be used for fire protection/emergency medical services staffing and operational expenses.
