Scanning and resolving of the test deck to be used in the Logic and Accuracy test was conducted during the week of June 1, 2018 and will be available for public review prior to the Logic and Accuracy test.

Candidates and representatives of the news media are encouraged to attend in order that we may answer any questions you might have prior to election night.

We request that the Central Committee Chairperson of each party attend or designate one representative to observe the proceedings and operations of the election center.
